A quality that combines;

- Respect / esteem.
- Pride / happy.
- Honesty.
- Trustworthy.

Assurance from the Lord. V15.

I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised



♦ Jacob built an altar. V18.

Early the next morning Jacob took the stone he had placed under his head and set it up as a pillar and poured oil on top of it.



♦ Jacob made a vow. V20:

Then Jacob made a vow, saying, "If God will be with me and will watch over me on this journey I am taking and will give me food to eat and clothes to wear

⇒ Personal.

⇒ Conscious decision.

⇒ Godly.

Content of vow:

If God will be with me.

If God will watch over me.

If God will give me food.

If God will give me clothes.

 If God will bring me back safe.

- * Then!
 - The Lord will be my God.
 - The stone will be God's house.

Of all that God will give me,
 I will give a tenth.

- ⇒ Hebrew (*Ma'ser*) meaning tenth part.
- Malachi 3:10-18

Required from:

⇒ I will prevent pests. V11.

"Then all the nations will call you blessed, for yours will be a delightful land," says the LORD Almighty.

⇒ A scroll of remembrance.

V16.

Then those who feared the LORD talked with each other, and the LORD listened and heard. A scroll of remembrance was written in his presence concerning those who feared the LORD and honored his name.

→ The righteous will have their Goshen.
